1. Presidential Address: Welcome and Opening Remarks

Meeting started at 09:16 by Bowen Tang, Secretary, followed by Sidsel Munkebo Hansen, President who participated remotely via live video feed. A full transcript of her opening remarks is included below:

One of my own personal highlights is our Summer Camp held in Denmark just within 1,5 months from now. It is no secret that I'm very thrilled that we, at this moment - 1,5 year after the very first meetings with our cooperative partners in Denmark - are having registrations from 60 young hard of hearing participants, coming from 12 different countries. And we have a very great program with only few details missing — there will be a lot of teambuilding, exciting workshops and presentations on music, culture and international relations — as well as a lot of outdoor activities, beach party, whole-day trip to Copenhagen and all its sights and in the end a big gala dinner. I'm very proud of the efforts made by the planning team situated in Denmark as well as the rest of the IFHOHYP board for their contribution to the realization of this big event. Actually there is four days left for registration, so this is your final chance for a lifetime experience!

It's also my last AGM as a president and board member as you all know. I had to realize that the time and flexibility this engagement deserve isn't there anymore, now that I've founded a family. I step back with mixed feelings. I'm incredible sad because I'm still passionate about IFHOHYP, the people and our cause - and not least I will really miss the people I have worked with, especially the board members, Alper, Daria, Bowen, Ece and Victor - it's been a pleasure working together with you guys. You are all very talented and you are awesome and fun to hang out with, even when we were having marathon-board-meetings on skype and difficult tasks to overcome. You can always count on me as a resource, if you need feedback or a second thought on anything in the new board. At the same time, I'm also filled up with happiness at this moment. I'm very proud of having been a part of the first baby steps this organisation is taking towards a stable structure and a new strategy which will enable us to have educational activities for young Hard of Hearing and making this group visible at an international level. And I'm also happy because of the very qualified candidates for the board, which means it will become a very strong board, and therefore it is much easier for me to hand everything over @I hope the new board will keep being ambitious although it requires a lot of hard work.

My final words as president will be to encourage you all to keep being committed and ambitious in your great work for the hard of hearing youth - both in your home countries as well in the international community as our network in IFHOHYP. Remember that every small or big volunteering contribution can have bigger impact, than you know – and that every contribution helps IFHOHYP becoming a powerful voice of the young hard of hearing.

9. Approval of the Minutes of the AGM 2015.

10. Presentation of the Annual Report 2015-2016

Bowen, Secretary and Victor, Board Member, presented the activities of the organization from December 2015 to June 2016. Highlights include representation at European Day of Persons with Disabilities, UN Conference of State Parties on CRPD, and continual partnership with EFHOH & IFHOH. It was also announced here that IFHOHYP has been accepted for a study session in Spring 2017.

11. Presentation of the Financial Report 2015

Daria, Treasurer, presented the financial report. An operational grant of $\[\in \]$ 16,228.30 was received in 2015 and as such, IFHOHYP was able to fund more activities and representation compared to previous years. As of December 31st 2015, IFHOHYP has a surplus of $\[\in \]$ 11,792.30.

12. Presentation of the Auditor's Report 2015

Jenna Juntilla, the Auditor, presented and read aloud her report:

As auditor of IFHOHYP I have checked the financial report, the financial statements including bank statements and vouchers, and the minutes of the board meetings. The incomes and expenses of 2015 are correct in the financial report.

The minutes were written in a very clear way, very easy to read. Although, the format of the minutes of the board meetings could follow a similar template no matter who writes them.

Also I would recommend more detailed financial reports for the events, where the money is used precisely and not just the final costs. In addition it would be desirable that the expenses are paid as accurately as possible during the same year when expenses are used.

13. Approval of Annual Report, Financial Report, and Auditor's Report

Approved; no objections.

Note: After this point, Sara from Sh-Jong stated that membership payment has been submitted to IFHOHYP, verified by Daria, Treasurer. A motion was called to accept Sh-Jong as a voting member with Sara being the delegate. Approved; no objections.

The new quorum was declared: 3 board members, 12 delegates, and 12 observers.

14. Presentation of EFHOH/IFHOH

Aïda Regel Poulsen, Secretary of EFHOH, presented to the AGM. Ruth Warick, President of IFHOH, presented to the AGM.

15. Presentation and Approval of the Plan of Action 2016-2017

Victor, Board Member, presented the Plan of Action. Approved; no objections.

16. Presentation and Approval of the Budget 2017

Daria, Treasurer, presented the Budget. Approved; no objections.

17. Election of the Officers of the Board

Alper, Vice-President, presented the nominees. He also took the opportunity to make his remarks as outgoing Vice-President.

- Question from HLFU: Martin asked whether it is possible to accept nominations from the floor.
- Answer from the Board: The deadline has passed to accept nominations. A call has been sent out via email with appropriate time given for submissions.
- From the floor: There are several organizations/people who did not receive such email.
- Daria, on behalf of the Board, emphasized the importance of given up-to-date contact information so that emails do not get lost.
- Sidsel, on behalf of the Board, stated that the Constitution and the AGM working format did not explicitly state the process for accepting nominations and therefore is open to interpretation.
- Answer from the Board: In light of this development, nominations from the floor will be accepted. Approved; no objections.
- From the floor: The new Board should look into developing a clear procedure regarding nominations that can be followed for the near future.
- a) President (2-year term)

Nominee: Victor Rehn, Finland. Elected with 12 out of 12 votes.

b) Vice-President (2-year term)

Nominee: Bowen Tang, Canada. Elected with 12 out of 12 votes.

c) Secretary (1-year term)

Nominee: Astrid Fejrø, Denmark. Elected with 12 out of 12 votes

- d) Board Member (1-year term)
 - Statement from Jugehörig: Manuel nominated himself as a candidate for Board Member.
 - From the floor: Avi, IFHOH observer and vote inspector, declared that he has to leave the AGM. Ruth, IFHOH observer, has kindly offered to fill in his place.

Nominees:

Glenn Storsletten, Norway. 8 votes, elected.

Manuel Rohrbach, Switzerland. 4 votes.

18. Election of the Auditor for 2017.

Note: At this point, three delegates have left the AGM due to flight schedule. The new quorum was declared: 3 board members, 9 delegates, and 11 observers.

19. Presentation of the Committees.

- a) Communication and Information Committee, presented by Bowen, Vice-President.
 - 2 newsletters have been published, always looking for articles and people to join the team
- b) Expansion Committee, presented by Alper, IED.
 - Welcomed HLAA as our newest member, nothing further to report
- c) Summer Camp Committee, presented by Sidsel, Høreforeningen.

- Final planning is underway; 1.5 months to go!
- 63 participants from 12 different countries are attending
- d) Study Session Committee, presented by Camilla, Svenska Hörselförbundet.
 - Camilla reiterated that the study session proposal has been accepted by Council of Europe. Tentative date: Spring 2017.
 - She asked the AGM floor to spread the word out, particularly to recruit people in joining the preparatory team.

Question from HLFU: Martin suggested that Communication and Information Committee merge with Expansion Committee with the new name: Communication & Member Committee. Approved; no objections.

20. Motions

No motions have been submitted for this AGM. Jenna, Kuuloliitto Ry, suggested that the Board look into the feasibility of increasing number of people on the Board.
